

PREVIEW BALLOT – Jackson County * Nov. 8th MIDTERM Election

This is a PREVIEW BALLOT and will likely change. Following are the races and ballot measures we expect to be on local ballots.

Yellow indicates Democrats. **Green** indicates non-Democrats who have been endorsed by the Jackson County Democratic Party.

- Statewide: At least four measures will be on the Nov. 8 ballot:
 - [Measure 111](#): State must ensure affordable health care access; balanced against other essential services
 - [Measure 112](#): Removes language from Constitution allowing slavery and involuntary servitude as punishment
 - [Measure 113](#): Legislative Accountability Act (penalty for excessive absences)
 - [Measure 114](#): Reduction of Gun Violence Act (stricter permitting rules, limits on some ammunition)
