

Script for Going Door to Door

Before you contact voters:

- *Please read the Election Fact Sheet carefully. Carry copies with you.*
- *Also review the Voter's Pamphlet and consider carrying it with you.*

Feel free to adapt this script to your own style. When going door to door, please observe appropriate public health recommendations. Protect your voters and yourself.

Hi, I'm _____ . I'm your neighbor from _____ Street, and I'm a volunteer Neighborhood Leader getting out the vote for Jackson County Democrats.

We're having another election in May. Have you heard about it?

Discuss briefly if they're receptive. Let them share what they've heard; be a good listener. Answer questions as best you can. Write down those you aren't sure about and relay them to NLP@jcdemocrats.org and we'll get you the answer.

I have a one-page fact sheet about it. Would you like a copy?

Suggest they keep it on the fridge or in an easily remembered spot.

Ballots will be mailed Friday, April 28. Turnout is really low for special district elections. Can you believe it's less than 30 percent? The good news about that is your vote can make even more of a difference.

Can we count on you to vote in this election?

This is the most important question to ask them. An oral pledge to vote increases the likelihood they'll follow through.

That's great, thanks! We're asking folks to turn in their ballots as early as possible. That way you'll be taken off the call lists of the campaigns, and they can focus on people who haven't voted yet.
